INTRODUCTION

Government College Chhachhrauli, a co-educational multifaculty Higher Education Institution (HEI) was established by Haryana State Government in 2008. It is situated at Village Chhachhrauli in District Yamuna Nagar of Haryana State and affiliated to Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra. It was established to provide high-quality and value-based education to the rural and underprivileged students of thenearby areas of Chhachhrauli region at a low and affordable cost. The college with a motto of 'Come to Learn, Go to Serve' provides and supports a transformative experience on the campus where students are equipped and prepared for dealing with a world which is getting more complex every day.

and value-based education to rural, underprivileged and vulnerable segments of society at a low and affordable cost, and facilitate holistic growth of the students making them self-sufficient and socially responsible citizens.

Initially, the College was started in a make-shift arrangement building of Government Senior Secondary School, Chhachhrauli. In the very first year of its inception, 231 students were admitted to the undergraduate programmes in the Arts and Commerce streams. However, the College sublimed the heights of glory outshining in various fields in the coming years. The college was also given recognition under Section 2(f) and 12B of the UGC Act -1956 in the year 2015. The College also got permanent affiliation for its various courses since year 2015. Subsequently, in November

2013, the College was shifted to its own spacious lush green campus spread over 10.5 acres having modern state-of-the-art infrastructure and facilities.

At present, the College building has two blocks (one doublestoreyed and the other one four-storeyed).

Currently, the College is offering higher education in 03 Post-Graduate (PG) degree Programmes i.e. M.A. History, M.Com. & M.Sc. Computer Science (Software), 01 PG Diploma Programme i.e. PGDCA, and 05 Under-Graduate (UG) Programmes i.e. B.A, B.Com, BCA, B.Sc (Non-Medical & Medical) with student strength of 1549 in the current academic session (2023-24).

The College strives to achieve benchmarks in its academic content consistently and has thus implemented NEP-2020 in the first year of all UG programmesw.e.f. the session 2023-24. The staff members of the College are being trained for adoption and implementation of NEP, 2020 through various trainings, workshops, Short Term Programmes (STPs) etc. Some Staff members of the college have qualified the NEP Online Orientation and Sensitization Programmeorganized under MMTTC by different universities in the session 2023-24.

A team of 39 dedicated and well- qualified faculty members under the able patronage of Principal of the college facilitates effectual teaching and contributes in honing the academic skills of about 1500 students every year. The institution is

proud of its faculty which comprises the academicians of extraordinary caliber.

The admission process is merit-based, transparent and strictly in accordance with the State Government reservation policy through Centralized Online Admission Portal. At the onset of new academic session, an Orientation Programme is organized by the College for new entrants to acquaint them with various aspects of college life. The teaching-learning process is based on traditional chalk and board method blended with use of econtents, smart classroom, and virtual classroom. The examination system is based on the set, efficient and student-friendly system of the affiliating Kurukshetra University. The evaluation of students is made from their continuous performance by way of internal assessment, and semester-end performance in University examination (Theory and Practical examination, wherever applicable).

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college plays a vital and active role to ensure effective and quality teachinglearning.Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)is a significant administrative body of the institution framed with an objective to maintain quality benchmarks in the College. The IQAC regularly conducts its meetings to assess the college activities and facilities, and suggests the areas of improvement. In the session 2023-24, the College through the initiatives and efforts by core committee of IQAC and NAAC has been awarded 'B+' Grade in its 1stCycle by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with a CGPA of 2.61.

The Department of Higher Education Haryana has entrusted the responsibility of a **Mentor College** to this College under the Mentor-mentee programme. The process of mentoring has been adopted by the Department to facilitate the colleges undergoing the process of NAAC accreditation. Government College Chhachhrauli (Mentor College) has been assigned the responsibility of all the other 04 Government Colleges of District Yamuna Nagar.
